## INFORMATION NOTICE 189

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Dear Neighbour,

**Re: Basement 3 - Foundation & Pile Cap Pours, W/C 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021.**

On Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup>, Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November, we will continue the foundation pour at Basement Level 3. As advised in our Information Notice 154 (20<sup>th</sup> August), when concrete areas are poured it is imperative that the process is completed in one session, otherwise the integrity of the final structure could be compromised. Due to the thickness of the foundations and associated volume of concrete required, Westminster City Council have agreed to extend the working hours on these days to 07.00-20.00hrs.

This week's operations will require the use of three pumps, however outside normal working hours the process will be limited to:

- Pump 1 - located at basement level 1 (between 7am-8am and 6pm-8pm)
- Pump 2 - located at ground level in the north east corner of site (between 7am – 8am)

Each pumping machine located at ground level will be wrapped in acoustic blankets and to mitigate any inconvenience, we will cease the use of the pumps, as soon as is practically possible.
