Dear Neighbour,

Re: Large delivery, Mon 23rd March 1900

Following our last information notice (no. 43v2, 12th March), the date and time of our crawler crane delivery scheduled for 17th March has been rescheduled for tonight, please see below for details:

- **Monday 23rd March 19:00** – crawler crane delivery – to be unloaded on Queensway and tracked on to site

The operation should take no longer than 45 minutes-1 hour and, as usual, we will endeavour to minimise disruption as much as possible.

As outlined in previous notices, due to the size of the vehicles needed to transport large plant, we are obliged to deliver out of rush-hour:

- **For the morning deliveries**, the vehicle engine will be switched off as soon as it arrives in site, and the plant will be offloaded when site working hours commence at 8am.
- **For the evening deliveries**, the plant will be offloaded on site and the vehicle will leave immediately. No works will take place out of hours.

The delivery will arrive to site from Bishops Bridge Road, via Queensway and Redan Place.
