Re: Activity next week

Weekend deliveries

Please be informed, we will receive some deliveries to site during working hours on Saturday 2nd May. These should not cause any disruption and are not noisy works but you may notice a bit more activity on site than usual for a Saturday. Weekend working hours will remain the same with site closing at 1pm.

Activity next week

- **Mon 4th May-Thurs 7th May:** we will receive 4 deliveries of large equipment before 8am each morning these days. Due to the size of these vehicles, they must be off the road during rush hour. The vehicles will therefore be driven on to site at 7am, the engine switched off until site opening hours at 8am, when they will be unloaded and proceed to leave site. No works will take place out of hours.
- **Wednesday 6th May:** we will be demobilising one of our piling rigs on site on Wednesday. It will be loaded on to a low loader, tracked on to Queensway and taken away from site. Again, due to the size of the vehicle, it can only be on the road after rush hour, meaning the operation must take place after 6pm.

These operations should not cause any disruption, but we will endeavour to minimise disruption as much as possible.

All deliveries will arrive to site from Bishops Bridge Road, via Queensway and Redan Place North Gate 2 (Queensway end).
