Re:

- **Large deliveries w/c 17th Aug**
- **Crane remedial works Saturday 15th Aug**
- **Major remedial works w/c 17th and 24th Aug**

Next week – w/c 17th August – we will receive large deliveries between 6:50 and 7:00 Monday to Friday.

As outlined in previous notices, our large abnormal deliveries are required by the Metropolitan Police to be off the road network by 0700 in the morning. The vehicles will be driven on to site between 6:50-7:00. The engine will be switched off until site opening hours at 8am, when they will be unloaded and proceed to leave site. No works will take place out of hours. The deliveries will arrive to site from Bishops Bridge Road, via Queensway and Redan Place North Gate 2 (Queensway end). As usual, we will endeavour to minimise disruption as much as possible.

Additionally, some ground recently collapsed into one of our piles on site. This is not any cause for alarm for our neighbours, but to remedy this we are installing 2 additional piles and casings either side to ensure the ground is stable. We will be changing the configuration of our crane by shortening the crane jib to accommodate the weight of the new casings tomorrow, **Saturday 15th August**. The works will take place within site working hours (8am-1pm) but we have received a dispensation from Westminster City Council until 6pm *in case* the works run over. These works should not cause any disruption, but our immediate neighbours may notice this extra activity on site.

Over the next two weeks, when we will be installing the additional 2 piles, there is an overall medium risk of overruns. Please be assured that we do not expect these to be every day, but we will let our immediate neighbours know by 5pm on the days of these works if there will be an overrun. Again, we have received dispensation from WCC ahead of these works *in case* we have to run over our site working hours.
