Dear Neighbour,

**Re: Tower crane installation – reschedule of postponed works 21<sup>st</sup> Feb 2021**

Unfortunately, due to the adverse weather conditions (high winds) experienced last Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> February, we were unable to complete the full installation of Tower crane 3 as planned. We have now received confirmation that the wind conditions are forecast to improve by this coming Sunday (21<sup>st</sup> Feb), enabling us to complete the final stage of the installation.

In line with previous Tower Crane erections these works must be carried out over a weekend due to the high-risk nature of the operation, requiring a large exclusion zone with minimal people on site. We have informed Westminster City Council of the delay and they have provided their authority to complete the erection this weekend.

In terms of noise, the operations will involve (but is not limited to) the use of torque guns and occasionally a petrol saw for cutting materials. Whilst it is unavoidable to complete the operations without some noise, we will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum, all team members will be reminded to be mindful of our neighbours and the permitted working hours this weekend are 8.00-13.00hrs Saturday and 10.00-17.00hrs Sunday.
