INFORMATION NOTICE 102

Dear Neighbour,

Re: Planned Installations - Tower Crane (TC1) – TC5 Lift – Gate in Pitlane, Queensway

Please be informed that we have received permission from Westminster City Council for extended weekend working hours on Saturday 13th March & Sunday 14th March, in order to undertake several installations.

We shall be erecting the fifth and final Tower Crane (TC1), installing a lift to TC5 and constructing a closing gate system along the pitlane in Queensway.

As advised on previous occasions, tower crane erections and lift installations must be carried out over a weekend due to the high-risk nature of the operation, requiring a large exclusion zone with minimal people on site. In order to minimise disruption and reduce the need for further weekend working we have also synchronised the installation of the Queensway pitlane gate which can only be undertaken when there are no scheduled deliveries. The pitlane work can be safely distanced and partitioned away from the crane installation.

In terms of noise, the operations will involve (but is not limited to) the use of torque guns and occasionally a petrol saw for cutting materials. Whilst it is unavoidable to complete the operations without some noise, we will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum, all team members will be reminded to be mindful of our neighbours and the permitted working hours this weekend are Saturday 8.00-17.00hrs and Sunday 10.00-17.00hrs.
