INFORMATION NOTICE 104

Dear Neighbour,

Re: Planned Installations - Tower Crane (TC1) – TC5 Lift – Gate in Pitlane, Queensway

Please be informed that unfortunately because of high winds forecast for this weekend we have had to postpone the installation of Tower Crane 1, TC5 lift and the Queensway gate which were communicated to you within information notice 102. Having received permission from Westminster City Council we now intend to carry out these operations on the following weekend, Saturday 20th March & Sunday 21st March.

As advised on previous occasions, tower crane erections and lift installations must be carried out over a weekend due to the high-risk nature of the operation, requiring a large exclusion zone with minimal people on site.

In terms of noise, the operations will involve (but is not limited to) the use of torque guns and occasionally a petrol saw for cutting materials. Whilst it is unavoidable to complete the operations without some noise, we will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum, all team members will be reminded to be mindful of our neighbours and the permitted working hours this weekend are 8.00-17.00hrs Saturday and Sunday 10.00-17.00hrs.
