**Re: Planned Crane Servicing 15<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> May and Crane Bracing 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> May.**

Please be informed we will be undertaking crane servicing and maintenance activities on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> & Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> May and crane bracing on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

The servicing work being undertaken is a normal part of the crane's operation and is essential in ensuring that the equipment is kept in a good state of repair. Crane bracing is the welding of a support to the crane at the basement level, an operation that is undertaken to allow us to proceed further with our excavations. All the bracing work will occur at basement level one and the mezzanine floor and all activity will be contained underground. In line with previous operations performed in relation to the cranes these actions must be carried out over a weekend due to the high-risk nature of the operation and the requirement for a large exclusion zone with minimal people on site.

In order to undertake these works Westminster City Council has agreed to extend our normal Saturday working hours until 17.00hrs for the maintenance work and 18.00hrs for the bracing work.
