**Re: Planned Crane Dismantle & Repositioning.**

Further to our Information Notice 249, please be aware that we have now agreed details surrounding the removal and repositioning of tower crane 1 (TC1) which is in the northeast quadrant.

These works will take place next weekend - 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and will include the installation of a new crane on top of the structural build along the Queensway elevation and the removal of the current TC1. As operations associated with cranes are sensitive to weather conditions, particularly wind, we have planned and been given permission for contingency dates on the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> June 2022. The process will involve the use of other cranes on site, removing the need to bring additional mobile cranes to site.

As this is a high-risk operation requiring wide exclusion zones, Westminster City Council have given permission for extended weekend working hours: Saturday 13:00-18:00hrs and Sunday 09:00-18:00hrs. Whilst it is unavoidable to complete the operations without some noise, we will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum and all team members will be reminded to be mindful of our neighbours. Further details about the remaining tower cranes will be provided once final details have been agreed.
