Large collection, 26th October

Please be informed, we will have 1 late collection of large plant next week, this will occur on Monday evening.

As usual, the collection vehicles will be loaded during working hours, the engines will be switched off until 7pm when they will proceed to leave site.

Vehicles will arrive to site from Bishops Bridge Road, via Queensway and Redan Place North Gate 2 (Queensway end). We will endeavour to minimise disruption as much as possible.

As outlined in previous notices, we are required by the Metropolitan Police to ensure large abnormal vehicles do not enter the central London road network during peak hours.

Please note, for these collections to take place we will need to keep our site lights on later than usual. These will be switched off once the operations are completed.

Saturday working 8am-1pm

This Saturday, 24th October, we will be working usual site hours of 8am-1pm. Works to be carried out include:

- Cabin collection from pitlane on Queensway
- Tower crane service – this involves some works to be carried out on the jib of the crane so please do not be alarmed if you see operatives on the jib
- Dismantling of crawler crane in preparation for collection on Monday

None of these will be classed as 'noisy works' and we will endeavour to keep noise to a minimum, but you may notice a bit more activity on site.
