Re: Covid-19 update

Happy New Year – we hope all our neighbours had a good Christmas and a restful break.

The Prime Minister's announcement yesterday about England entering a third lockdown phase included instructions for the construction industry to continue operations:

"You can only leave home for work purposes where it is unreasonable for you to do your job from home, including but not limited to people who work within critical national infrastructure, construction or manufacturing that require in-person attendance."

This is much the same as previous lockdowns and as such, the Whiteley development will continue to operate through this current lockdown phase.

Since previous lockdowns, many of our staff members have continued to work from home full-time. We have instructed many more team members to take this approach until lockdown is lifted. We continue all our previous measures to protect our team and members of the public.

Our current works on site involve the construction of the sub and super-structures which will take us through the rest of the year, with roofing and façade works beginning in the spring.

We are closely monitoring government actions and advice on Covid-19. With the situation evolving rapidly however, we are reviewing our approach regularly to take appropriate measures in line with government advice.
