**Re: Adjustment to hoarding lines – extended weekend working hours 30<sup>th</sup>/31<sup>st</sup> Jan**

Please be informed we have received permission from Westminster City Council for extended weekend working hours to carry out an adjustment to the hoarding lines along Redan Place (North), allowing the construction of a pick-point for Tower Crane 2 (TC2) to unload vehicles.

Due to the space requirements needed to reposition the gate and to provide an adequate safe zone for our technicians, these works need to be undertaken during a period when there are minimal vehicle movements to and from the site.

The extended hours are Saturday 13.00-17.00hrs and Sunday 10.00-17.00hrs. In terms of noise, this is expected to be low level - TC2 and forklift trucks will be used to move the concrete posts and metal gates, there will also be drilling associated with fixing the plywood hoarding. These works will be localised to Redan Place (North) and will be undertaken by a small team of technicians.
