Dear Neighbour,

Re: Tower crane installation – extended weekend working hours 13th/14th Feb 2021

Unfortunately, due to an unforeseen technical issue which was identified late on Friday evening, we had to postpone last weekend's lift installation at short notice. We have requested and now received permission from Westminster City Council to reschedule the work to this coming weekend. Given the changeable weather conditions forecast across this week, there is a possibility that this schedule may still be subject to further amendment and if this is the case, we will update you accordingly.

As with previous Tower Crane erections, we must carry these works out over the weekend, as it is a high-risk operation that requires a large exclusion zone with minimal people on site.

In terms of noise, the operations will involve (but is not limited to) the use of torque guns and occasionally a petrol saw for cutting materials. Whilst it is unavoidable to complete the operations without some noise, we will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum, all team members will be reminded to be mindful of our neighbours and the permitted working hours are 8.00-17.00hrs Saturday and 10.00-17.00hrs Sunday.
